The Alumnae Panhellenic Association of Washington, D.C. will award scholarships for the 2008-2009 academic year to qualified applicants. In the past, the Association has awarded three scholarships of \$750 each. We expect to award at least the same amount of money this year, and reserve the right to determine based on the applications how many scholarships should be awarded.

The applicant eligibility criteria are as follows: (1) member in good standing of a fully participating sorority of the National Panhellenic Conference; (2) rising sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student in Fall 2008; and (3) from the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area or attending school in the Washington, D.C. metropolitan area. Applications are due by March 15, 2008.

Scholarship recipients will be chosen at the Association's discretion, based on a combination of merit and the quality of the short essay and recommendation. Recipients will be notified on or before April 15, 2008. Essay Topic: Describe a community service project with which you were involved, and why the experience was rewarding for you.

- (3) **Recommendation:** The recommender need not be a member of your sorority. Please choose someone who knows you and can speak to your abilities. Please ask your recommender to fill out the attached sheet and provide his or her recommendation to you in a sealed envelope signed across the seal.

- (4) A copy of your most recent school **transcript** (unofficial copies are acceptable), and any additional pages required for you to provide the requested information.
